

BABY PIP HAT



Instructions are to fit an infant sized head measuring @ 14-15 inches. To fit a newborn to 4 month old baby. You can easily change the size of the hat to custom fit your baby's head by making a gauge swatch and measuring the baby's head. Figure out how many stitches per inch.

Finished Dimensions:

Will fit head @ 14-15"

Instructions:

Version#1

Cast 60 st and divide evenly onto dpn. Connect and knit in the round.

Knit 5 rows in K1P1 pattern to form ribbed hat band.

Starting with row 6 knit st stitch until hat measures @ 5 _ inches or desired size.

Divide stitches evenly onto 2 needles & finish seam using the kitchener stitch.

Embellishment ideas below.

Version #2:

Cast 60 st and divide evenly onto dpn.

Connect and knit in the round following a K1P1 rib pattern.

Knit until hat measures @ 4 _ inches or desired size.

Divide stitches evenly onto 2 needles & finish seam using the kitchener stitch. (please note that the kitchener seam does not look seamless when done with a rib pattern)

Embellishment ideas for either version:

Create pom-poms or tassels to place on corners of hat.

You can also leave the corners plain or stitch them so they look like kitty ears.
