



Materials:

- ~ 1 skein of Material Whirled yarn approx. 90+ yards
(Less yarn? Knit with a larger needle.) The crazier the yarn the better!
- ~ Size 10 - 11, 16 in. circular needles
- ~ Size 10 - 11 double point needles (dpn)
- ~ Stitch markers
- ~ Yarn needle

Finished Dimensions:

Will fit approx. 20-21 in. larger child or adult head.

Hat lying flat measures approx. 10" across brim edge and 10" from brim edge to tip of point

Instructions:

- ~ Cast 60 st onto circular needles. Connect and knit in the round, placing a marker at beginning. Continue until hat measures 4 inches from brim.
- ~ Place a marker every 10 stitches.
- ~ Decrease round 1 as follows: *k8, k2tog, sm*, repeat around.
- ~ Knit 4-6 rows normally.
- ~ Decrease round 2 as follows: *k7, k2tog, sm*, repeat around.
- ~ Knit 4-6 rows normally
- ~ Continue to decrease and knit 3 rows between decrease (switching to dpn when necessary), until 6 st remain on needles.
- ~ Cut yarn, thread end on yarn needle and connect all stitches, securing opening.
